28/07/26 Fwd_ Clophill PC Visit – Clophill Cllr who attended last night's meeting thanked MPC for welcoming them and forwarded contact details to all Cllrs and clerk for future collaboration opportunities, also trying to link with Haynes, Gravenhurst and Silsoe.

Clerk sent to Cllrs with suggested response using existing info and MPC decisions pointing out unsuitability of Woodcocks Path at under 6ft wide and disturbance to graveyard, and asking for date of promised meeting with CBC. Three cllrs responded with approval by Aug 12 date so response sent to CBC.

Clerk said it would be investigated and contacted Maulden Magpies as the sign may be theirs. Magpies responded it's fine to remove. Clerk asked Rec Cllrs if they could take it down. Maulden StreetWatch also reported this. Cllr Illingworth removed the sign.

12/08/26 Booking display board for banner – The Art Club requested the VH board Sept 20-Oct 11, clerk confirmed and put them on the list.

13/08/26 Maulden Action Group – Drop-in Session and LAG Discussions – new action group chair requested numbers for Local Plan drop-in session to gauge level of engagement locally, clerk said a guesstimate was around 50, quite a good level of engagement but there are 3,300 residents, and explained getting details of events to residents is always an issue, MPC use the website, noticeboards, posters in the pubs and shop, Maulden magazine and Facebook pages but there are always those who say they didn't see the notices. Said MPC are very happy to work with a local action group but the remit needs to be guided by CPRE who have the knowledge and experience to help set up and support, and that Cllr Aston is happy to join the LAG. MAG responded they will come back following discussions with CPRE.
